## Groundwork

The evolution of the social sciences in general and sociology in particular in Spain and Latin America since the mid-twentieth century is an interesting intellectual contribution to Western thought.

We recall that the various strands of sociological thought that make the ideological, political, economic, social and cultural aspects of Spain, Portugal and Latin America are inputs own sociological knowledge that should be socialized at a global level.

We would then be able to say that the lack of inter-sociological dialogue with Spain, Portugal and Latin America prevents improves global synergy

We need to build and deepen the links between the sociological theories of social change and conflict, revolutions, imperial relations, the nation states crisis, translational blocks, authoritarianism, populism, social relations between dominant, subordinate and popular class, perceptions and social representations construction, the opinion formation, the religion, cultural, political, urban, economic, education sociologies and psycho-sociologies, among others.

That is why we believe that a pluralistic enrichment exchange and inter-sociological proposal should avoid the lack of valid partners as it can make the sociology of Spain, Portugal and Latin America and would be an alternative source that could nourish the Israeli sociology.

In turn, the exponents of the sociology of Israel are not sufficiently analyzed in Latin America, Spain and Portugal, so it is in many ways, the widening gap of misunderstanding of the Israeli reality and its impact of the creation of the State of Israel phenomenon, its current dynamics in the global neo-liberal model, post-industrial and confrontation with its neighbours, also it must be analyzed from a plural perspective.
